

The First NASA LCLUC Science Meeting April 8-10, 1997, Airlie Conference Center, Warrenton, Virginia.

The objectives of the meeting were to:

1. Present to the LCLUC science team the program objectives and its role within the NASA ESE program.
2. Present the initial round LCLUC research projects, identify potential synergy's and foster collaboration between the LCLUC regional projects.
3. Examine the potential role and relationships to on-going LUCC activities within NASA, other US Agencies and internationally.

The meeting consisted of presentations on the selected LCLUC research projects, presentations from LCLUC related, NASA funded research projects and programmatic presentations on LCLUC related programs. The newly selected LCLUC investigators were asked to prepare a short presentation outlining the goals and planned deliverables of their research, the methodology to be adopted, a work schedule, a data management plan and the principle points of contact for the different aspects of the study. The presentations identified changes to the proposals made in response to reviewers recommendations.
